COOPERATIVE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA BOARD OF TRUSTEES

FRIEDRICH-ALEXANDER UNIVERSITÄT

Purpose

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"), dated as of May 5, 2020, is to promote international cooperation in fields of shared interest and expertise between the University of Florida Board of Trustees, a public body corporate of the State of Florida, on behalf of its College of Health & Human Performance, located in Gainesville, Florida, United States of America, and the Friedrich-Alexander Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg (FAU), on behalf of its FAU Graduate School in Advanced Optical Technologies and the FAU Institute of Medical Biotechnology located in Erlangen, Germany.

Types of Cooperation

Recognizing the importance of collaboration and the contributions to society made by institutions of higher education, the parties hereby express their interest in promoting mutually beneficial academic and scientific exchange between the faculties and students of the two institutions. Through this MOU, both parties agree to endeavor to promote such activities including, but not limited to, the following:

- Discussions of potential collaborative research;
- · Opportunities for faculty development and exchange;
- Opportunities for student development and exchange;
- Exchange of academic publications and reports;
- Sharing of experiences in innovative teaching methods and course design; and
- Organization of joint symposia, workshops, and conferences.

This MOU is a statement of intent and does not create any legally binding obligations between the parties, nor does it place any financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either party. Specific activities that the parties desire to undertake require separate written agreements that detail the terms, conditions, and commitment of resources (financial or otherwise) required of each party in connection with the specific activity.

Term

This MOU is effective as of the date first above written and shall remain valid for a period of five (5) years, with the understanding that it may be modified only by the written mutual consent of both parties. Either party may terminate this MOU with advance written notice to the other party of at least thirty (30) days.
